Application Procedure: Send your application to: Leadership MWV, c/o MWVCC, 2617 White Mountain Highway (Po Box 2300), North Conway, NH 03860.

The program will begin on January 11th.

Program: The nine Leadership MWV sessions take place on intermittent Wednesdays from January through June. Program days generally run from 8:30 am – 12:30 pm with lunch provided, with some optional tours and in-depth presentations scheduled for the afternoons. Participants have action assignments throughout the program of approximately 2-6 hours, as well as 2-4 hours of selected readings for each session; they are encouraged to outline their personal learning goals and to track progress on these goals during the year. To graduate, participants must attend at least 8 days in their entirety. Due to space and insurance considerations, participants may not bring dependents to the program sessions.

Tuition: Tuition is \$500. Leadership MWV urges employers to support participants by providing tuition assistance. A \$100 deposit is due immediately upon acceptance into the program. The remaining tuition is due before the first course session in January 2012. Program costs are incurred in advance; therefore, tuition fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Financial Aid: Please indicate whether you will require financial assistance in order to participate. Checking this box does not affect consideration of your application.

Financial Aid information is desired.

Selection: All applications are due by November 25th, 2011 and final admission decisions will be made by the Selection Committee. Accepted applicants will be notified by mid December 2011.
